 as he y^e S. William Penn shall please to give unto me my Parcoll bring much smaller
 then Espenaik^e and Swanpe^e. Hereby for me my heirs and Assignes renouncing all claims
 or demands of any thing in or for y^e future from him his heirs and Assignes. In Witness
 whereof I have her unto sett my hand and Seale y^e day and year first above written.
