

NOT NED MASK

What did Ned Kelly's recognisable mask tell about him? Did you check out the Kelly Gang armour in the *Not Just Ned* exhibition? Children can make their own 'Not Ned' mask at home to reflect their own personality.



Not Ned Mask instructions

What you will need:

Brown paper bag
Visor template (supplied – on reverse)
Magazines or newspapers from around home
Scissors
Glue stick
Coloured pencils or textas
Other embellishments or decorations from around home
Plain or patterned paper in your favourite colours

What to do:

Flick through the magazines or papers to see things that might represent you or your interests (eg. favourite foods, words that describe you, hobbies, animals). Cut these out with your scissors. You won't need too many (10 is a good number).

Using the template on the reverse, draw then cut out a rectangle for your eyes on the bag. You might need help from an adult to do this.

On both the sides of the bag, cut out an arch shape for your shoulders.

Using the glue stick, stick down the pictures and paper on your mask.

Embellish with decorations or colour in with pencils and textas.
