Go on a symbolic journey across Australia and travel 100 kilometres in only one step!

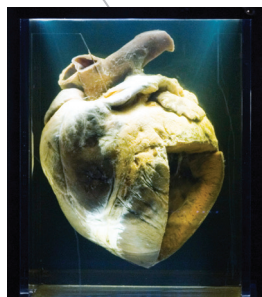

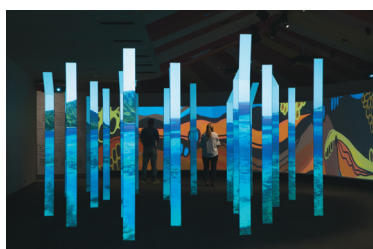


## ROCK SHOVEL BUCKET

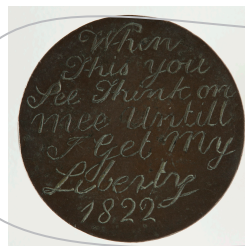

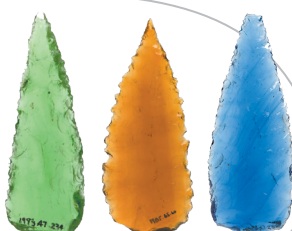
