## SENSORY MAP

This exhibition features a representation of a volcanic eruption using large-scale projections and soundscapes. It happens every 15 minutes and involves loud noises and changing light levels.

The area most affected by the immersive experience is highlighted in grey.

### What to expect:

The eruption happens every 15 minutes. The total eruption time is less than 1 minute.

These timings are approximate:

- 0–24 seconds: rumbling and ash cloud on volcano projection only.
- 24–30 seconds: raining ash.
- 30–38 seconds: ash cloud sweeps through the exhibition.
- 38–45 seconds: darkness.
- 45–50 seconds: return to original state.



### CONTENT ADVICE

**This display contains copies of casts of some of the victims of the eruption in 79 CE. They represent 4 people (3 adults and 1 child) and a dog in their final moments.**

#### PROJECTIONS

Large moving image.



#### OVERHEAD SPEAKER

May be associated with a particular video or provide ambient sound.



#### INTERACTIVE

Use touchscreen to play.



#### HEARING LOOP

Use T switch for direct transmission. Areas are highlighted in blue.



#### Video components

All documentary video content is subtitled.



#### How long is this video?

Look for the timer in the bottom right corner of the video.
