- 1** The **Old New Land** gallery examines Australia's diverse and unique species and environments by exploring how people have responded and adapted to the land over time. **G**
- 2** The **Journeys** gallery explores the fascinating journeys of people and objects that connect Australia to the world. **L1**
- 3** The **Landmarks** gallery is located on two levels and features over 1500 objects. It explores Australian history since European settlement, through stories of Australian places from across the continent. **G/LG**

our highlights

The **Gandel Atrium** showcases objects from the Museum's collection and explores defining moments in Australia's history. It is named in honour of John Gandel AC and Pauline Gandel who have supported a Museum education program, the Defining Moments Digital Classroom. **G**

The **Circa theatre** plays host to exciting **Virtual Reality experiences**. Ask a Museum host or visit the Information Desk for more information on session times and tickets.

Kspace is an interactive adventure game for kids. Visitors build their own time-travelling robot and are transported back in time to a mystery place in Australia's past. See a host for information on session times.

The **Garden of Australian Dreams** is a remarkable garden made up of maps and symbols, where every step you take equates to 100 kilometres across the continent.

The **Paddle Steamer Enterprise** is one of the world's oldest working paddle steamers. Today, following careful restoration and conservation, it is the largest working exhibit at the Museum.
