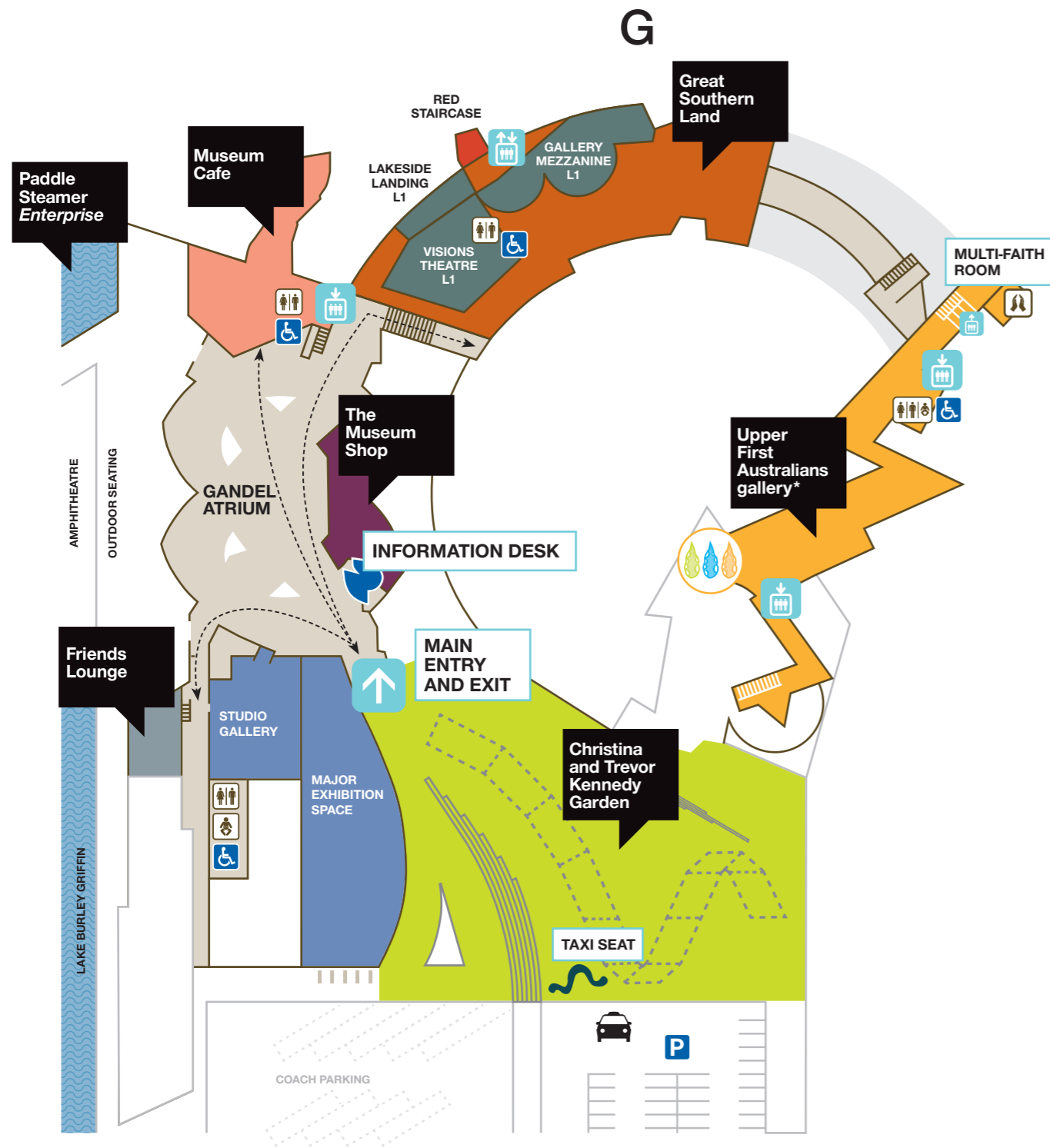

Great Southern Land A new environmental gallery exploring our relationship to the land and our unique continent. Explore the natural forces which have shaped life in Australia, our biodiversity and evolving environment.

Visions Theatre, Lakeside Landing and the Gallery Mezzanine are multi-use spaces that host collection displays, programs, functions and events. Located on Level 1, they are accessed by the red staircase or from the lift inside Great Southern Land.

Landmarks gallery Explore Australian history since European settlement and find some of the Museum's most treasured objects, including Phar Lap's heart and the Holden Prototype no. 1.

Garden of Australian Dreams Wander through the rich landscape of symbols that identify place, Country and home.

Tim and Gina Fairfax Discovery Centre (costs apply) A new play space for 0-6 year olds is being developed to help immerse young minds, bodies and hearts in the great stories of Australia.

First Australians gallery Trace the experiences of Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander peoples, their spirituality,

diversity, identity and survival. Don't miss the exquisite Kimberley points (spearheads).
