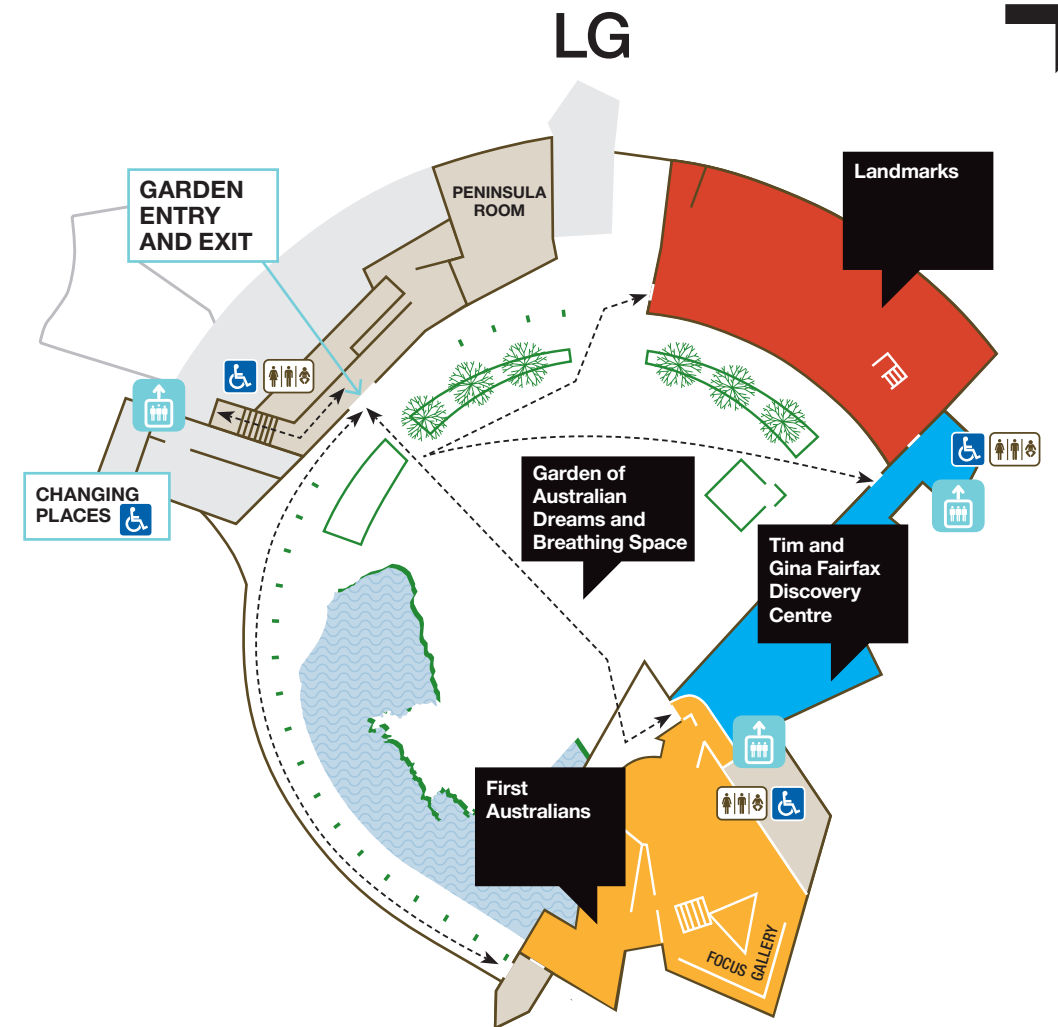
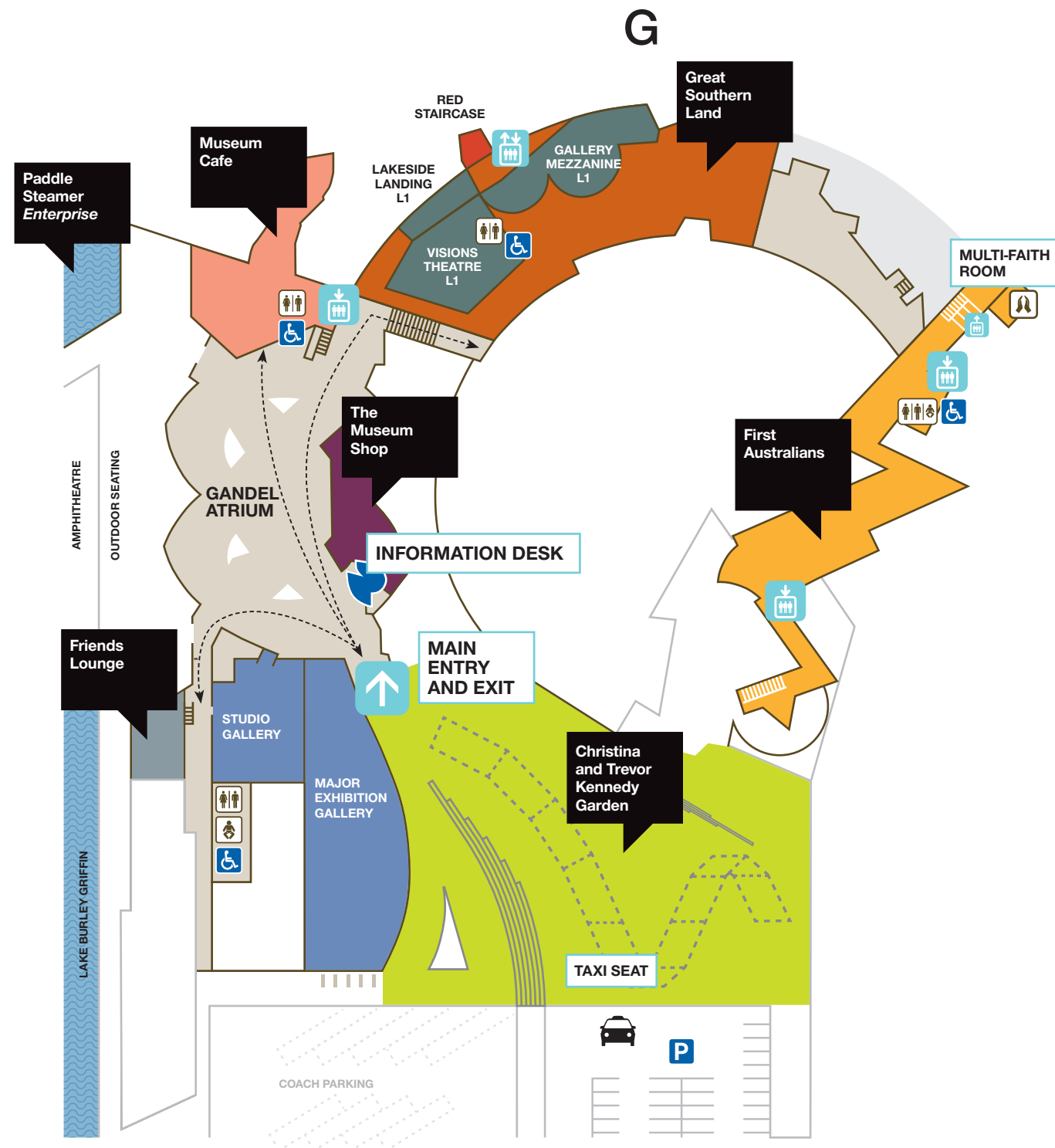

Great Southern Land Discover an environmental gallery exploring our relationship to the land and our unique continent. Explore the natural forces which have shaped life in Australia, our biodiversity and evolving environment.

Visions Theatre, Lakeside Landing and Gallery Mezzanine are multi-use spaces that host collection displays, virtual reality experiences, programs, functions and events. Located on Level 1, they are accessed by the red staircase or from the lift nearby.

Garden of Australian Dreams and Breathing Space Wander through the rich landscape of symbols that identify place, Country and home.
