They used lots of cool recycled materials such as meat trays, cotton reels, egg cartons, cardboard boxes as well as new shiny stuff! A great attaching tool called makedo was used to join and hinge surfaces together.

Future space house or city instructions

What you will need:

Pencils and paper (for your design).

Recycled things such as boxes, food trays (cleaned), tubes or cartons.

Scissors.

Glue or sticky tape.

makedo (optional).

Coloured paper / corrugated cardboard / pipe cleaners / pencils / textas / stickers for decoration (optional).

What to do:

It's a great idea to draw your future house with pencils on paper first. You might like to look through some books for inspiration. If you have been to Kspace before you might remember some of the things you designed.

Once you know what you are doing, build your model using the materials you have collected. Use the makedo or tape and glue to join things together. If you are building a city of the future, you can just keep adding to it.
