

Image pricing schedule July 2023

The National Museum of Australia processes image requests within 4 weeks where possible. A quote can be provided if requested.

The Museum reserves the right to refuse to license any image or to limit the use of any licensed image.

As part of obligations under the Museum's <u>First Nations cultural rights and engagement policy</u>, if your request involves First Nations content the process may involve community/cultural clearance.

Where copyright is held externally, the Museum will need to see proof of copyright permission prior to providing an image.

All prices are in Australian dollars and exclude GST. GST will be included in the quote.

Any transaction or bank fees are the responsibility of the purchaser. Images will only be supplied on receipt of full payment.

Services

Photography

Costs will apply when a new image of a collection item is required (see table below). Additional photography charges may apply under some circumstances – for example, where objects must be moved from one store to another (freight) or contractors are used to meet a schedule.

A quote for photographic services will normally be provided prior to commencement of any work.

Photography fees are in addition to relevant supply and licence fees.

Merchandise

Licence for merchandise is negotiated on an individual basis.

Display/exhibition

Licence for exhibition purposes includes all exhibition-related use: graphic panel (printed and digital), educational supplements and websites, audiovisual material on monitors and touchscreens, and review of the exhibition (printed and digital).

Licence for use in a single production. The fees are the same for either standard or non-standard television and film, regional or network TV (including cable, satellite and streaming).
